

BYLAW NO. 130/2005

A BYLAW TO AMEND A BYLAW

The Council of the Rural Municipal of Indian Head No. 156 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. That Bylaw No. 226/2004 respecting the establishment of a Public Utility Board pursuant to Section 228.1 of the Rural Municipality Act, 1989, be amended as follows:

A) by removing Section 2 (a) of Exhibit "A" and adding

" the power, pursuant to clause 228(1)(a.1) and subsection 228(2) of the Act, to recover the cost of the installation of the public utility in the manner described in subsection 237(3) of the Act, if the following conditions are met:

- i) the fair value assessment of the property receiving the Public Utility Service must be at least \$25,000.00
- ii) all arrears of taxes on all land owned by an individual must be paid in full before the water pipeline will be installed onto the property
- iii) the Board will maintain a contingency fund equal to 15% of its' annual tax levy, which this fund will be used to pay for that portion of the Water Utility Board's annual tax levy which remains uncollected after December 31<sup>st</sup> of any year and which is to be used for payments to the financial institution to whom the board is indebted.
- iv) the total cost of the installation work is to be paid for over no more than 15 years

B) by removing Section 2.(e)

C) by removing from Section 3. (a) the words "At the first meeting of the Subscribers, 3 members shall be elected to the Board for a 2 year term and 2 members shall be elected to the Board for a 1 year term. Following the first annual meeting of the subscribers, all Board members shall be elected for 2 year terms" and adding the words "The Board shall consist of six members, one of them a member of and appointed by resolution of the municipal council as an ex-officio member."

2. This bylaw shall come into effect on the day it is adopted by Council.
