

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONTROL AND DESTRUCTION OF GRASSHOPPERS ON LAND WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Indian Head No. 156 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this Bylaw the expression:
 - "Chemical Distribution Outlet" means the depot as appointed by Council from time to time;
 - "Committee" means members appointed by the Municipality;
 - "Council" means the Council of the Rural Municipality of Indian Head No. 156;
 - "Municipality" means the Rural Municipality of Indian Head No. 156;
 - "Owner" means every person who owns, occupies or controls land within the Municipality.
2. The Council shall, in each year, appoint a committee to be known as the "Grasshopper Control Cdmmitttee" to administer this bylaw.
3. Every owner shall take the following measures for the control and destruction of grasshoppers:
 - he shall be responsible for the application of chemicals on his land, that is, in his opinion and/or in the opinion of the Committee, warrants such application, and
 - he shall be responsible for the application of chemicals within the area lying between the centre line of the road allowance adjoining his land and the nearest boundary of the said land, that is, in his opinion and/or the opinion of the Committee, warrants such application; and
 - he shall trap strip all of his stubble fields within the area of the municipality where he has failed to destroy all green growth early and before grasshoppers hatch, that is, in his opinion and/or in the opinion of the Committee warrants such action.
4. Any application of chemicals or trap stripping in default of being done by the owner, the matter or thing shall be done at the expense of the person in default, and the municipality may recover the expenses thereof with costs in like manner as municipal taxes or the expenses may be added to and form part of the taxes on that person's land on which or with respect to which the work was done.
5. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided for in the General Penalty Bylaw of this municipality.
6. Bylaws No. 2-34, No. 4-50 and No. 1-63 are hereby repealed.
7. This bylaw shall remain in force until repealed by bylaw of the Municipality.
