


BYLAW NO. 148-86


A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR JOINT FUNDING OF RAILWAY PROTECTIVE DEVICES.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Indian Head No. 156 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:


1. The Rural Municipality of Indian Head No. 156, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Council of The Town of Indian Head, the terms of which are attached hereto and marked Exhibit "A" for the purpose of providing joint funding as the Road Authority for automatic protective devices at railway crossing Mileage 49.50 Indian Head Subdivision.
2. The reeve and administrator of the Rural Municipality of Indian Head No. 156 are hereby authorized to sign and execute an agreement, the terms of which are set out in Exhibit "A" herebefore referred to.

THIS AGREEMENT made in duplicate this 15th day of April, 1986, A.D.

BETWEEN: The Rural Municipality of Indian Head No. 156
a municipal corporation of and in the Province
of Saskatchewan (Party of the First Part)

AND

The Town of Indian Head
a municipal corporation of and in the Province
of Saskatchewan (Party of the Second Part)

WHEREAS the Canadian Transport Commission, Railway Transport Committee have inspected and recommend that automatic protective devices, consisting of two (2) flashing light signals and one (1) bell, be installed at Canadian Pacific Limited crossing located at Mileage 49.50 Indian Head Subdivision on Municipal road between Sections 13 and 18-18-12-W2, East Access Road to Town; and

WHEREAS the recommended installation and future maintenance costs are shared as follows:

A) Installation Construction Cost

- 80.0% Federal Government
- 7.5% Railway Company
- 12.5% Road Authority (Rural and Urban Municipalities)

Saskatchewan Rural Development will provide 50% assistance on the Road Authority's share.

B) Annual Maintenance Cost

- 50% Railway Company
- 50% Road Authority

Saskatchewan Rural Development will provide 50% assistance on the Road Authority's share upon submission of accounts.

THEREFORE THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH THAT:

- 1) The Parties to this agreement agree to participate in the cost sharing of said railway protective devices (signalization) at CPR Crossing Mileage 49.50 Indian Head Subdivision.
- 2) The Parties agree to participate jointly and equally as the Road Authority.
- 3) The Rural Municipality of Indian Head No. 156 will pay initially the accounts and submit to the Town of Indian Head an account for its 50% share less the 50% assistance available from Saskatchewan Rural Development. Accounts to be paid within 30 days.
- 4) This agreement shall be continuous until terminated by either party hereto giving to the other party ninety (90) days written notice of its intention to terminate this agreement.
