


BYLAW NO. 175/90

A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF INDIAN HEAD NO. 156
TO PROVIDE FOR ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT
WITH
THE TOWN OF INDIAN HEAD
TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A
MUNICIPAL HERITAGE ADVISORY COMMITTEE


The Council of the Rural Municipality of Indian Head No. 156, in the Province of Saskatchewan enact as follows:

1. The Rural Municipality of Indian Head No. 156 is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, attached hereto and identified as Appendix "A" which forms part of this Bylaw, with the Council of the Town of Indian Head, for the purpose of establishing a Municipal Heritage Advisory Committee.
2. The Reeve and Administrator of the Rural Municipality of Indian Head No. 156 are hereby authorized to sign and execute an agreement, the terms of which are set out in Appendix "A", hereinbefore referred to.

BETWEEN:

The Town of Indian Head
a Municipal Corporation of and in the
Province of Saskatchewan
(Party of the First Part)

and

The Rural Municipality of Indian Head No. 156
a Municipal Corporation of an in the
Province of Saskatchewan
(Party of the Second Part)

WHEREAS pursuant to the Heritage Property Act S.S. 1979-80 Cap. H-2.2 as amended, the parties hereto empowered to establish a Municipal Heritage Advisory Committee to advise and assist the Council on any matter arising out of the said Act or the regulations; and

WHEREAS the Councils of the said Municipalities deem it expedient and in the general interest of the community to appoint a Municipal Heritage Advisory Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL FOR THE TOWN OF INDIAN HEAD AND THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL FOR THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF INDIAN HEAD NO. 156 AGREE AS FOLLOWS:


1. A Municipal Heritage Advisory Committee is hereby established for the purpose of advising and assisting the Councils of the said Municipalities on any matter arising out of The Heritage Property Act, S.S. 1979-80 Cap. H-2.2 as amended, or the regulations thereto.
2. The Municipal Heritage Advisory Committee shall be comprised of six (6) members which shall be appointed by the Council of the Town of Indian Head and the Council of the Rural Municipality of Indian Head No. 156 in the manner hereinafter provided:
 - (a) three (3) persons residing in the Town of Indian Head appointed by the Council of the Town of Indian Head,
 - (b) three (3) persons representing the Rural Municipality of Indian Head No. 156 appointed by the Council of the Rural Municipality of Indian Head No. 156.
3. The Mayor and Reeve are ex-officio members of the Committee.
4. Members shall hold office until their successors are appointed by resolution of Council.
5.
 - (a) The Committee shall appoint its own Chairperson and Secretary.
 - (b) The Committee shall meet at the call of the Chairperson or when requested, in writing, by three (3) members of the Committee.
 - (c) The Chairperson shall preside at all meetings of the Committee at which he/she is present and in this/her absence the Committee shall name one of the other members present as Chairperson, pro tempore.

(d) The Chairperson shall have the same voting right as the other members of the Committee and shall present all reports or recommendations of the Committee to the Councils.


(e) The Committee shall keep records of its proceedings.

6. A majority of the members shall be necessary to form a quorum and no business shall be transacted unless there is a quorum.




