

**BYLAW NO. 190/20**

**RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF INDIAN HEAD NO. 156**

A bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 172/90, known as the Zoning Bylaw.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Indian Head No. 156 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts to amend Bylaw No. 172/90 as follows:

**1. Part V, A-Agricultural Zone, is amended by adding the following directly after section 8(ii):**

- (iii) At the request of the current owner of the site proposed to be subdivided, Council may use its discretion to vary the maximum site size requirement where the change:
  - (a) is requested to include additional land required for water supply or waste disposal systems which exist on the proposed site; or
  - (b) is requested to include or facilitate any existing landscaping, buildings, structures or natural features on the proposed site; and
  - (c) would not unnecessarily reduce, or negatively affect the existing use, size, servicing or access to the balance of the quarter section or adjacent land parcels.

**2. This bylaw shall come into force on the date of final approval by the Minister of Government Relations.**
