A BYLAW FOR THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF INDIAN HEAD IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO PROVIDE FOR ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT RESPECTING THE INSTALLATION OF A BULK WATER TOWER TO PROVIDE BULK WATER.


The Council of the RM of Indian Head in the Province of Saskatchewan,
enacts as follows:

1. The RM of Indian Head is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw, and identified as Exhibit "A" with the Town of Indian Head., for the purposes stated within this agreement.
2. That the Reeve and Administrator of the RM of Indian Head are hereby authorized to sign the attached agreement identified as "Exhibit "A".







BULK WATER/WATER TOWER AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

the **TOWN OF INDIAN HEAD** (the Town), a Municipal Corporation located in the Province of Saskatchewan

and

the **RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF INDIAN HEAD NO. 156** (the RM), a Municipal Corporation located in the Province of Saskatchewan

WHEREAS the Town and the RM have discussed the construction of a bulk water tower to serve RM residents;

AND WHEREAS the proposed bulk water tower is to be located within the RM of Indian Head Shop Yard;

NOW THEREFORE THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSES that in consideration of the mutual agreements and conditions contained herein, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. CONSTRUCTION AND INSTALLATION

1.1 The Town agrees to extend a two-inch water line south from the existing asbestos cement (AC) watermain located north of the RM of Indian Head Shop Yard to the RM's north property line.

1.2 The RM agrees to continue the installation of the two-inch water line from the north property line to the designated site of the proposed bulk water tower within the RM Shop Yard.

1.3 The RM shall be responsible for the construction of the bulk water filling station, including the installation of all equipment and infrastructure required for operation.

2. WATER METERING AND BILLING

2.1 The Town shall install a water meter within a meter pit at the bulk water tower site to measure water usage.

2.2 The Town shall bill the RM quarterly based on the water meter readings.

2.3 The rate charged to the RM shall reflect the current water rates charged to the residents of the Town of Indian Head.

2.4 The RM shall be responsible for the collection and sale of water to RM residents or users.

3. SITE DEVELOPMENT

3.1 The RM shall construct appropriate approaches for entering and exiting the bulk water tower site.

3.2 The RM shall construct and maintain a designated parking area to accommodate multiple users accessing the bulk water tower at one time.

4. MAINTENANCE RESPONSIBILITIES

4.1 The Town shall be responsible only for the maintenance and repair of the water line from the existing Town watermain to the RM's north property line.

4.2 The RM shall be solely responsible for the maintenance, operation, and repair of all infrastructure located within its property, including but not limited to the two-inch water line, bulk water tower, filling station equipment, meter pit, approaches, and parking area.

4.3 The RM shall ensure that all maintenance and operational activities comply with provincial water regulations and standards.

5. EMERGENCY AUTHORITY

5.1 The Town retains the right to reduce or temporarily discontinue water supply to the bulk water tower in the event of an emergency, including but not limited to water shortages, infrastructure failures, maintenance requirements, or circumstances affecting the Town's ability to provide safe drinking water.

5.2 In such events, the Town shall provide notice to the RM as soon as reasonably possible and shall resume normal service when conditions permit.

6. TERMINATION

6.1 This agreement may be terminated by either party with twelve (12) months' written notice, provided that such termination is approved by both Councils by resolution.

7. TERMS OF AGREEMENT

7.1 This agreement shall take effect upon the date of signing and shall remain in force until amended or terminated in accordance with Section 6.


7.2 Both parties agree to adopt this agreement by bylaw in accordance with The Municipalities Act.


