

BYLAW NO. 229/05

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Indian Head No. 156 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this Bylaw:

(a) "all terrain vehicles" means all terrain vehicles as defined in The All Terrain Vehicles Act, 1988.

(b) "highway" means a highway as defined in The Highway Traffic Act.

2. Pursuant to Section 9(1), All Terrain Vehicles Act, a person is hereby authorized to operate an all terrain vehicle on the traveled portion of any highway, other than a Provincial Highway, within the Rural Municipality of Indian Head No. 156.

3. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any provision of this bylaw shall be subject to the penalties as provided under The All Terrain Vehicles Act, 1988.

4. This Bylaw will be reviewed in April, 2006.
