STAFFING

RATES AND CHARGES

SNOW CLEARING/LANE GRADING:

Only main access grids are kept open in the winter. Exercise caution when travelling on summer only roads as they are not always open during winter months.

The RM does provide lane grading and snow clearing as a custom service. This is an as time permits service only. In the case of heavy snowfall, municipal roads will be done first, followed by private residences.

Zoning Districts, Development & Home-Based Businesses

Did you know that the RM of Indian Head is divided into 7 zoning districts that regulate everything from What you can build, setbacks and permitted uses within the property? Depending on where you live in the RM, different rules outline what is permitted, and what is not. Do you want to build a house, put up a fence or start a business? You will have to make sure the proposed development fits within your district's zoning guidelines and apply for a development Permit. Our [Zoning Bylaw No. 172/90](#) contains all the information for each district. Both the Development Permit Application and full Zoning Bylaw can be obtained by contacting the office.

BUILDING BYLAW

Effective January 1, 2024 the RM has put in place the Provincial building bylaw while we wait for final approval on our own. As such, any renovation or construction of buildings with a residential component now require a building permit as well as inspections from our contracted building inspector. See the attached document for a summary of what requires a permit and of which type.
