## SNOW CLEARING/LANE GRADING:

Only main access grids are kept open in the winter. Exercise caution when travelling on summer only roads as they are not always open during winter months.

The RM does provide snow clearing on lanes as a custom charge service. This is an as time permits service only. In the case of heavy snowfall, municipal roads will be done first, followed by lanes.

## SNOW REMOVAL

Please take a minute to familiarize yourself with the RM's snow removal policy.

Piles of pushed snow left on or near the road can freeze into a solid mass creating a hazardous situation for vehicles and snowplows. It could also increase the chance of drifting on to the roadway.

This hazard on a municipal road expose those that use the road (residents, equipment operators etc.) to the risk of serious bodily injury and poses the risk of liability for the resulting damages to the party who pushed the snow on the road. Anyone who pushes snow on to a municipal road can also be liable for the costs for the R.M to remedy the damage done and can be fined under *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997*.

## TIRE RECYCLING

Did you know you can recycle tires at Indian Head Chrysler? Their tire program allows for up to 10 tires per day to be dropped off. To participate, you must visit the service counter at the dealership to complete a form to inform them about your drop off each time you use the program.

## ZONING DISTRICTS, DEVELOPMENT & HOME-BASED BUSINESSES

Did you know that the RM of Indian Head is divided into 7 zoning districts that regulate everything from what you can build, setbacks and permitted uses within the property? Depending on where you live in the RM, different rules outline what is permitted, and what is not. Do you want to build a house, put up a fence or start a business? You will have to make sure the proposed development fits within your district's zoning guidelines and apply for a development Permit. Our [Zoning Bylaw No. 172/90](#) contains all the information for each district. Both the Development Permit Application and full Zoning Bylaw can be obtained by contacting the office.
